**The school reports will be handed out in the first lesson on 30<sup>th</sup> June. At 8.45 pupils can go home. The school care centre will no longer be open, nor will the school canteen.**

In the last week of August, you can expect the first Newsletter with fresh information about the start of the new school year. The new school year begins on Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> September.
