Cambridge Exams

Cloverleaf Elementary School has already sent you the dates for the CE exams, which will take place at our school (excluding FCE level) on Friday, May 10th, and Saturday, May 11th. The Friday Speaking test will take place shortly after classes, so children attending after-school care can go directly from there and return afterward. Students will attend the exams by themselves and you can pick them up after the exam in front of the school or, if applicable, on the fourth floor where the bilingual classes are located.
